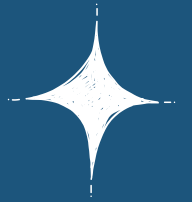
Poorva Yasaswi

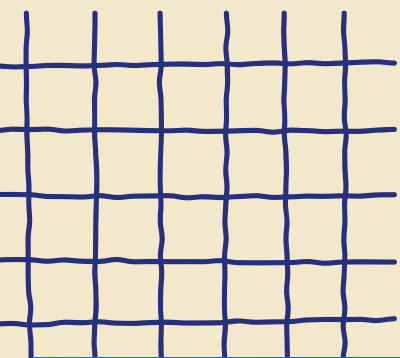
The Wait is Over: New Student Council Leaders Embrace the Future

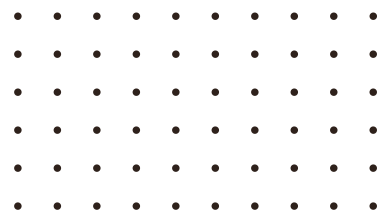
POPULATION MATTERS

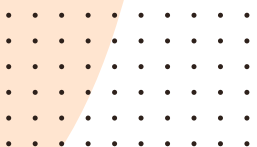
BUDGETING, SAVING AND INVESTING!

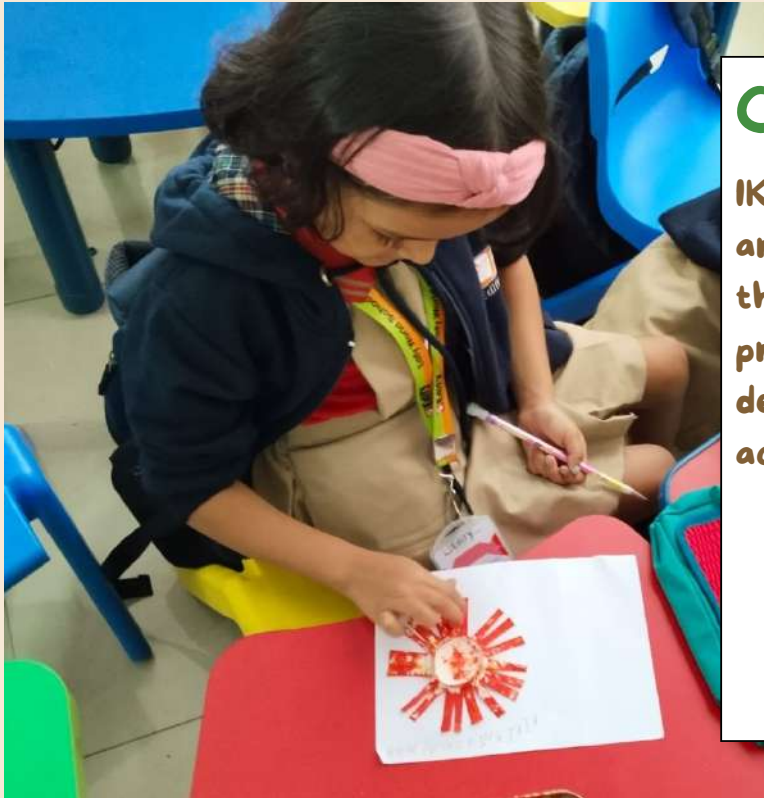


Early childhood education thrives!

IK-3 Engaged in Sense Organs Sorting Activity

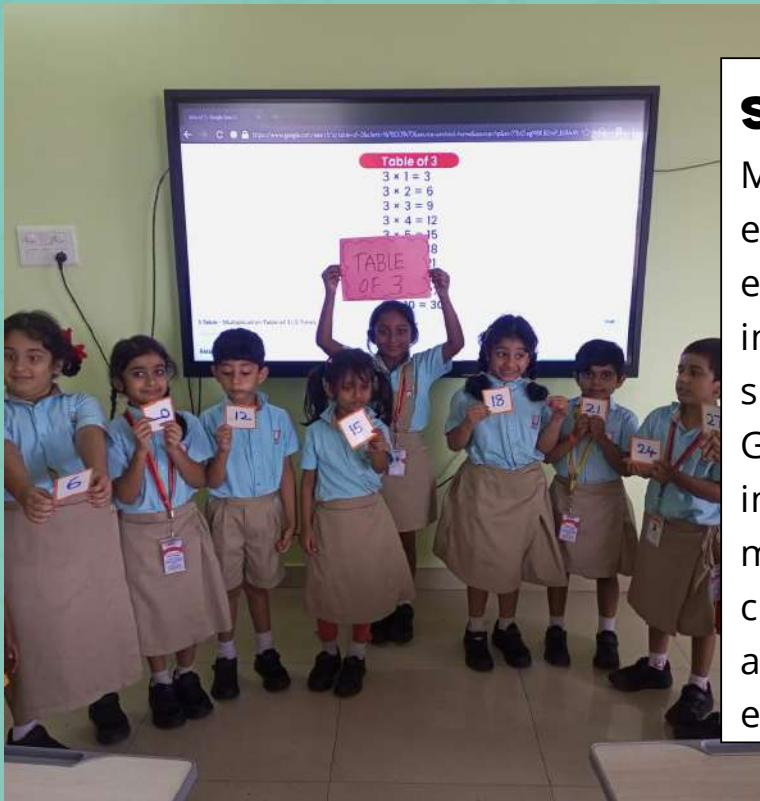

SKIP COUNTING

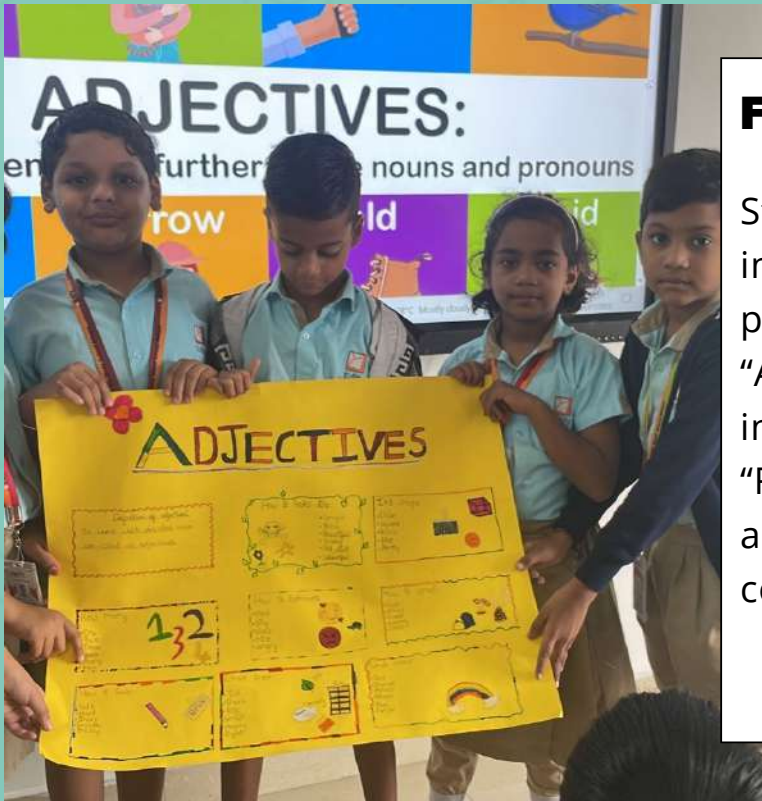

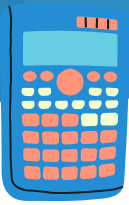
FISHING FOR KNOWLEDGE

Our Telangana's Vibrant Culture

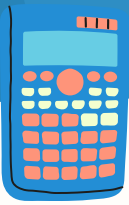

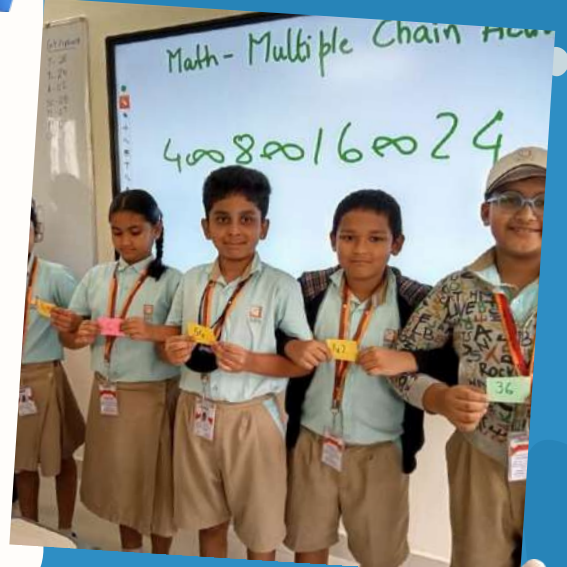


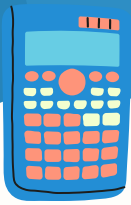
Fostering Dexterity and Learning

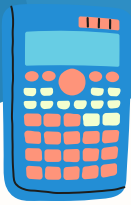
Fluttering fractions

TIPS FROM OUR COUNSELLOR

Hello, all lovely parents I know you all were curiously waiting. So here I am with an interesting topic: Mindful Parenting

Mindful parenting refers to being involved or giving complete attention to your child. It's being completely present to their needs, emotions and feelings. Here are some tips to help you develop mindful parenting.

- First and foremost, self-awareness: let's first be aware of our own emotions and reactions.

Understand how and why you react to different situations with your children by acknowledging your own feelings without judging them.

- Show empathy and validate your child's feelings without ignoring or belittling them.

Remember you are the world to them and they want you to understand them.

- Now, let's talk about how to strengthen your relationship with your child by connecting with them at the right time. Give them a warm hug and kiss when they wake up in the morning, and spend some time waking them up with positive, loving words.
- When they arrive home from school, ask them to share, listen to their experiences, engage in play activities and show them you are interested in them and their talk.
- Bedtime: Bedtime can become a special ritual where you talk about the day, plan what your child will do the next day, and express gratitude for what they have.

Adding these to your daily routines will enhance your parent-child relationship and make it even stronger and more loving.

We all do it, but we could be a bit more mindful about it. It's important to remember that every child is different, so let's pay attention to their cues and preferences to find out when they are most receptive to bonding and conversation. Ultimately, the key is to be consistent.
