

In an assembly by Grade 2 Achievers, the students left everyone amazed by portraying Benjamin Franklin's role in discovering electricity through a captivating dance performance.


ROADWAY RYTHMS

Who doesn't like to enjoy a cake that is not only delicious but also healthy and can be made instantly? This guilt-free cake can be relished anytime. I have tried this recipe, and it turned out to be super yummy, so I would like to share the recipe with you all.

Here it goes:

Ingredients:

1. Wheat flour - 150gms (1 bowl)
2. Three ripe small bananas - mash them up
3. Sugar - 120gms (roughly 3/4 of the quantity of wheat)
4. 1 teaspoon baking soda and 1 teaspoon baking powder.
5. Butter - 3/4 bowl (140gms)
6. Eggs - 2
7. Roasted walnuts and cashew nuts - 1/2 bowl (100gms)
8. Chocolate chips - half a bowl
9. Vanilla essence - 1 teaspoon


Process of Preparation:

Whisk 2 eggs for 5 minutes in a bowl. Add butter, sugar, baking powder, baking soda, wheat

flour, and mashed bananas. Mix the batter well. Finally, add chopped walnuts, cashew nuts, and chocolate chips to the mixture. Pour the batter into a greased baking pan. Preheat the oven to 180° and bake the cake for 45 minutes. Let the cake cool down on a cooling rack and then enjoy.

PARENTING TIPS: "SPREADING LOVE"

Spreading Love, One Word at a Time - Why Expressing Positivity Between Parents Creates a Flourishing Environment for Child Development?
Did you grow up hearing your parents saying encouraging words about one another? Do you know the positive impact it had on you?

For Example:

"Let's ask Daddy what he thinks, he usually has creative ideas."

"I appreciate how hard your mom or dad works to provide for our family. It shows her dedication and responsibility."

"I appreciate your dad making efforts to spend time with us on weekends, though he is very busy. It makes our family bond even stronger."

WHY & HOW DOES IT MATTER?

Kids feel safe and secure knowing their parents feel secure with one another.

Your child hearing you express love and respect towards your partner: their parent, gives them confidence in their world.

Also, practicing saying kind things about your partner reminds us that we actually believe in them, even though we have opportunities to believe otherwise throughout the day.






