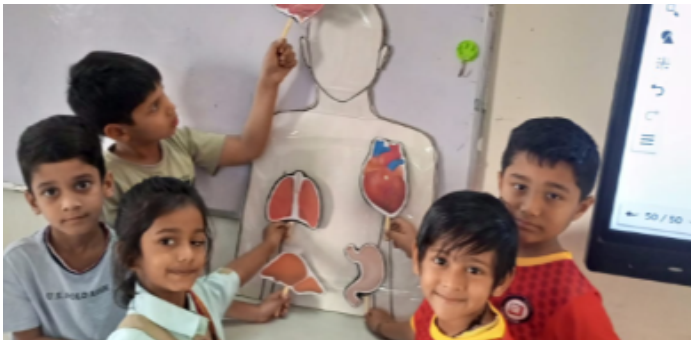
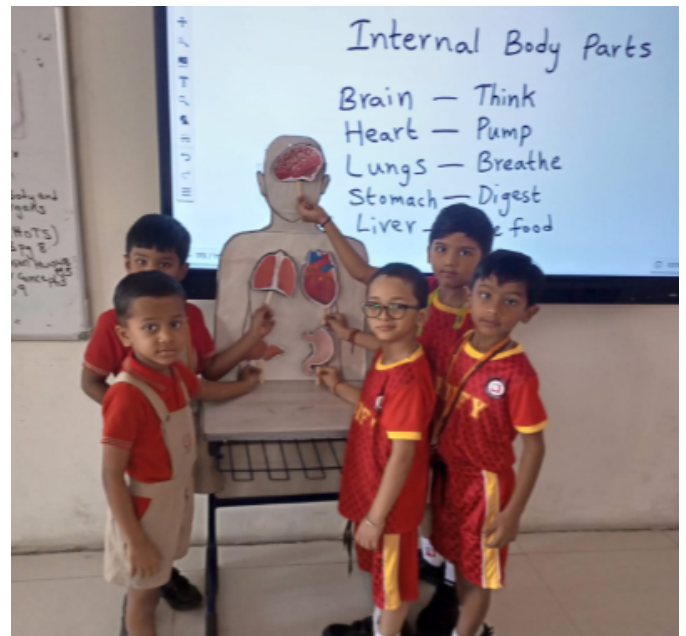
### Pre-Number Magic at Edifians!

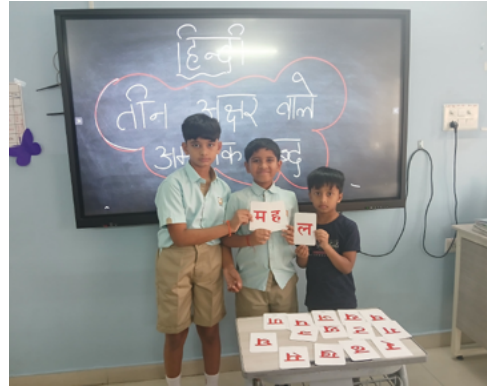

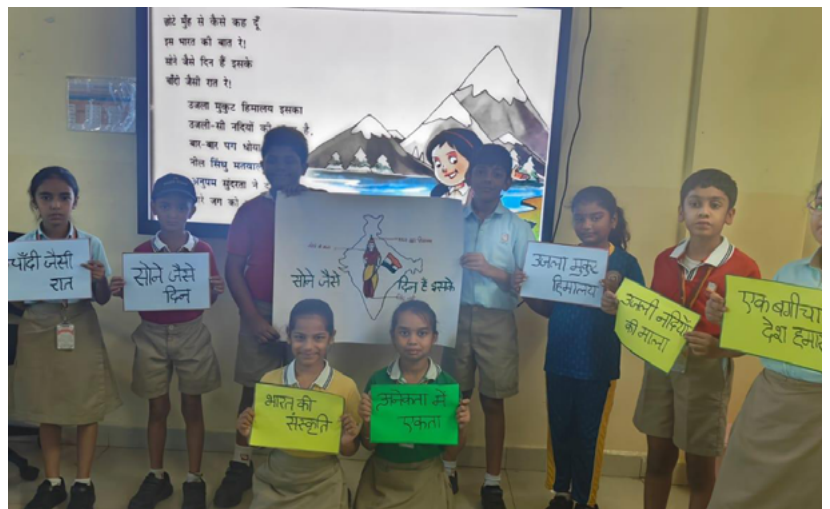
## LEARNING IN ACTION (CURRICULUM HIGHLIGHTS)

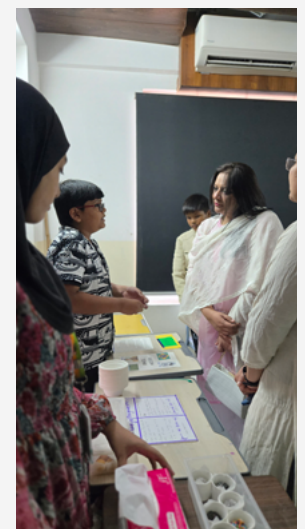

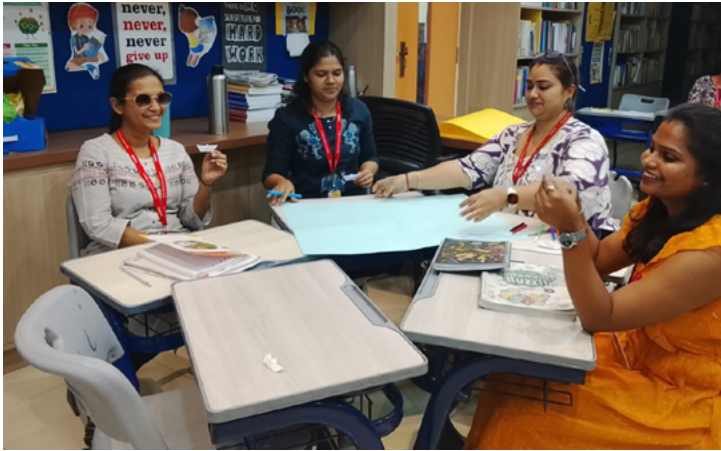
Teachers actively participated in a range of hands-on activities designed to simplify complex concepts and

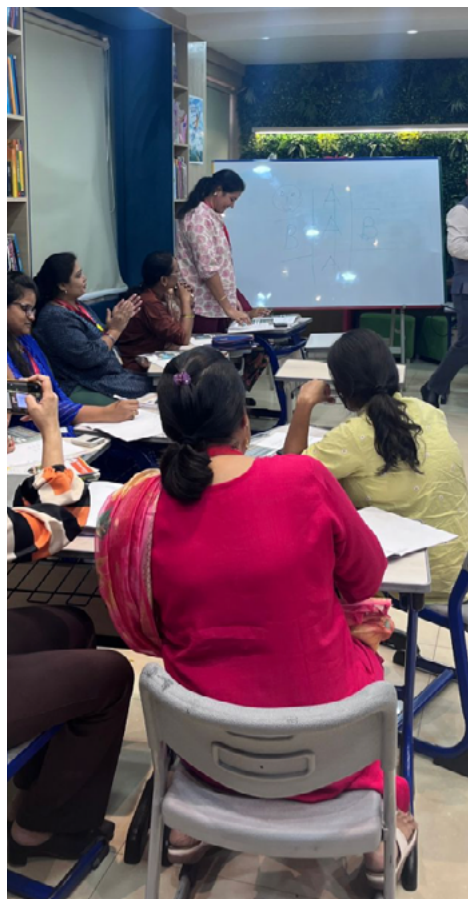
### Inspiring Session Transforms Teaching Approaches for EVS, Social & Science Educators
